The Regional Municipality of York (York Region) has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for road improvements to Leslie Street from Wellington Street to

Mulock Drive to accommodate existing and future traffic requirements. This section of Leslie Street has been identified for improvements as part of York Region's 2002 Transportation Master Plan.

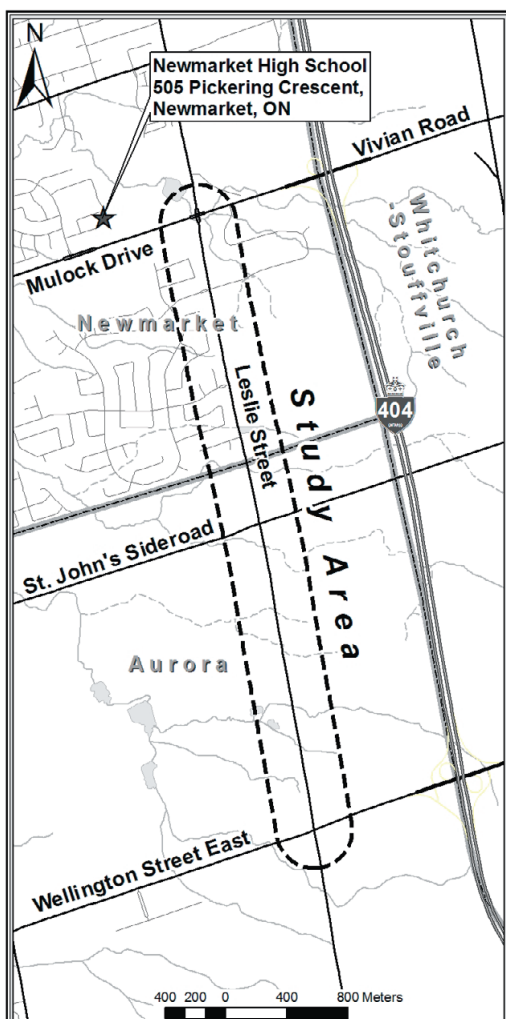
This study is being undertaken as a Schedule 'C' project in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007).
